Hosted by Norfolk County Beekeepers Association

Our course is designed for people who wish to gain an understanding of bee biology and beekeeping practices in order to begin the fascinating art of beekeeping. Those who are just curious or are as yet unsure about beginning this endeavor are also encouraged to enroll. Classes will consist of seven or eight weekly meetings (depending on progress made). Beginning at 7:00 pm and ending around 9 or 9:30. Classes will be held at the Norfolk County Agricultural School cafeteria in Walpole with some classes as lectures and others hands-on style with participation in assembling beekeeping equipment. In addition to the above, there will be one field demonstration in April on Installing a package of bees into a new hive.

The dates for the school are : February 5, 12, 26, March 4, 11, 18, 25, and April 1, 8. Tuition is \$50.00 per person (including families). The tuition includes beekeeping equipment supply catalogues, and related hand outs. The course material is downloadable. If you wish to have a hardcopy, please include an additional \$10.00.
